F.W. & Ruth Hatterscheidt

Fred W. Hatterscheidt was a prominent businessman from the Aberdeen area during the 20th Century. He was born in Cologne, Germany on January 29, 1893 to Joseph and Margaretha Hatterscheidt. He attended the Aberdeen Public Schools and after completion attended Northern State Teachers College and Aberdeen Business College. After college he became widely involved in area businesses, real estate, and investments. He was secretary of Narregang Investment Co. of Aberdeen from 1914-1930 and became president of Narregang-Hart Co. of Aberdeen from 1930-1936 and director of Narregang Holding Corporation from its organization in 1927. He became president of the Farmers & Merchants Bank of Aberdeen beginning in 1955 and was the founder and president of the Hatterscheidt Foundation Inc., which started the Hatterscheidt scholarships.

Along with his many business affairs he was also actively involved in civic affairs, and had served in the military as a Captain during WWI. (Who's Who in South Dakota, 1961, p. 61.) He was also actively involved in his hobby of big game hunting throughout the world and many examples of his trophy hunts can be observed at the Dacotah Prairie Museum in Aberdeen.

Fred Hatterscheidt and his wife, Ruth, had no children but left an endowment through the Foundation to aid many of the area students hoping to further their education. The primary purpose of the Hatterscheidt Foundation is to provide college scholarships to current seniors graduating from South Dakota high schools. The secondary purpose is to provide financial support to various non-profit organizations located within South Dakota. The Hatterscheidt Foundation currently provides 140 scholarships each year in the amount of \$1,500 per scholarship. Students receiving them can attend most of the post-secondary schools located within South Dakota.
